ORDINANCE NO. 5, 2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT TO
THE AUSTIN CITY PLANNING COMMISSION
SETTING TERMS THEREFORE; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AUSTIN, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Whereas all positions of the Austin Planning Commission are currently not filled,

Section 2. Whereas, a full complement of members is necessary for the proper operation of the
Planning Commission,

Section 3. The following individual is re- appointed to the City of Austin Planning Commission for a
term as set forth herein: Position 4: Jeremy Reed Term Ending: January 31, 2006.

Section 4. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity
shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid
provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. Emergency. Whereas the proper operation of the Planning Commission is of great
importance to the City of Austin; and, this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the
public health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage.
