

Austin City Council Meeting  
March 27, 2017

Mayor Bernie Chamberlain called to Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Councilman Randy Ryan led the members in prayer. Recorder Shirley Sudduth called the roll. Council members attending were Phillip Whiting, Rusty Eisenhower, Laurel Carnes, Randy Ryan, Tammy Williams, and Matthew Sheets. All members were present.

February's Council Minutes were approved without opposition. Randy Ryan made the motion for acceptance with Rusty Eisenhower seconding the motion.

February's Financial Report was accepted with the adjustment on the Revenue Fund's beginning balance (\$10.00 correction). Matthew Sheets made the motion to accept the Financial Report with the correction. Rusty Eisenhower seconded the motion. There was no opposition.

Water/Sewer:

1. Bids for street repair: Shadow Creek/Hudson Branch was \$3,075.00; West Main/Weatherly was \$2,700.00; and parking lot seal and repair was \$2,775.00. Phillip Whiting made the motion to approve the street repairs with Rusty Eisenhower seconding the motion. There was no opposition. The motion passed.
2. Additions to City Hall: The bids were \$1,200.00 for sidewalks and \$1,400.00 for asphalt by White's Paving, Inc. Randy Ryan made the motion for the asphalt and concrete work to be taken out of the General Fund account. Rusty Eisenhower seconded the motion. There was no opposition. The motion passed.
3. Mosquito spraying will begin in April.
