

Austin City Council Meeting  
August 28, 2017

Mayor Bernie Chamberlain called the City Council Meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Councilman Randy Ryan opened the meeting with prayer. Recorder Shirley Sudduth called roll. Council members present were Phillip Whiting, Tammy Williams, Randy Ryan, Rusty Eisenhower, Laurel Carnes, and Kasai Finley. All members were present.
